Dear Mr. @TMDILH and Dad

**Re: Child (d.o.b. 2000))**

This is to advise you that after the Society completed our investigation with respect to the above-mentioned child, we were further contacted on two separate occasions due to issues surrounding the custody and access of Child

A police report was received stating that after Dolores dropped Child off for an access visit with the agreed upon third party, she chose to stay until you arrived, thus putting you in direct violation of your restraining order. This is clearly a violation that was preempted by Dolores and she was cautioned around this violation. You attended my office and we discussed this issue and also discussed the emotional abuse these incidents put on Child and you were advised to come up with another plan for dropping off and picking up Child from access visits. You discussed your dissatisfaction with Dolores and her reluctance to relinquishing your access to your daughter. I clearly advised you that the Society does not involve itself with custody/access disputes and that you need to work these issues out within the courts. You were cautioned about continuing to subject Child to these situations and advised to work out the dropping of Child off to ensure that there would be no contact between yourself and Dolores.

A week later the Society once again was contacted and advised that there was yet another situation, involving the police, whereby Dolores refused to give you your scheduled access visit over the Christmas holidays. When you did get some access to Child you decided to break the agreement as well, and not return Child at the agreed upon scheduled time. It is further alleged that Dolores then followed Michael and Child and when Michael left the vehicle, Dolores got in and drove away with Child with Michael attempting to stop them, grabbing on to the vehicle. There was then apparently a situation at the police station whereby all adults were yelling and screaming at each other, with Child present the whole time.

This letter is a final caution to both you and to Dolores. The Durham Children's Aid Society is a protection agency that does not become involved in custody/access battles. Therefore, the two of you need to resolve these issues within the courts and comply with what the judge decides with respect to access to Child. However, if it continues that the two of you are putting Child in the middle of your battles and exposing her to yelling and screaming, the Society will be in a position to apprehend Child and take her into our custody. Then access to her for both yourself and Dolores will be at our discretion and we will protect Child from being subjected to this emotional abuse that you both continue to expose her to.
