ON CONSENT, THIS COURT ORDERS THAT:

1. The Respondent father shall have the child, child born as follows:
 - a. every other weekend from Friday at 5:00 p.m. to Monday at 9:00 a.m. starting July 22, 2005;
 - b. every Wednesday from 5:00 p.m. to Thursday at 9:00 a.m.;
 - c. each party shall have the right of first refusal in the event the other cannot care for child, so that a parent, not a sitter will be used, and will communicate in that regard; and
 - d. the parties will endeavour to be flexible and cooperative in sharing child and in allowing child to phone the other while in the other's care.
2. The parties agree to attend mediation and to enrol in mediation within 10 days of this Order.
3. The parties will share the driving to facilitate each other's time with child. The pick up and drop off shall occur at a MacDonald's in Port Perry, or a MacDonald's in Oshawa, depending on who has the alternating obligation to drive.
