2. If she does not do so by September 30, 2005, the Respondent may serve and file an Answer and cross-claim which includes an equalization claim.
3. If the case does not settle in mediation, each party is to serve and file an updated Financial Statement 10 days before the next court attendance.
4. The Applicant agrees to instruct the listing agent, Ernie Ticms, with Sutton Group, Oshawa, to proceed with all required steps to sell the matrimonial home, including a "For Sale" sign on the property, etc.
5. The proceeds from the sale of the matrimonial home shall be held in trust by the parties' real estate lawyer.
